**ORDER CALLING FOR AN ELECTION TO BE HELD
MAY 4, 2024, AND DEFINING BOUNDARIES**

Now comes Donley County, Texas, a political subdivision of the State of Texas, acting by and through its Commissioners Court, and pursuant to §387.03, Texas Local Government Code, and §323.101 Texas Tax Code, calls for an election to create four (3) County Assistance Districts, to be held on a uniform election date, i.e. May 4, 2024. Said election will include all portions of the County of Donley.

Section 1

Description of Districts

Pursuant to §387.003 (b), the boundaries of each of three (3) districts are as follows:

1. District 1: District 1 will be composed of such territory as exists within the municipal boundaries the date of the election, May 4, 2024, of the City of Howardwick, Texas, but excluding territory within the extraterritorial jurisdiction of said city.
2. District 2: District 2 will be composed of such territory as exists within the municipal boundaries the date of the election, May 4, 2024, of the City of Hedley, Texas, but excluding territory within the extraterritorial jurisdiction of said city.
3. District 3: District 3 will be composed of all territory lying within the boundaries of Donley County, situated outside the municipal boundaries of the municipalities of Clarendon, Howardwick and Hedley, Texas.

Section 2

Call for Election

Pursuant to this Order, an election for the creation of three (3) County Assistance District is hereby called for May 4, 2024 with the boundaries set forth above.

Section 3
Ballot Styles

The ballot at the election shall be printed to permit voting for or against the proposition:

1. District 1 ballot style:

“Authorizing the creation of the Donley County Assistance District No. 1, and the imposition of a sales and use tax at the rate of 1.0 percent for purpose of financing the operations of the district.

For _____ Against _____”

2. District 2 ballot style:

“Authorizing the creation of the Donley County Assistance District No. 2, and the imposition of a sales and use tax at the rate of 1.0 percent for purpose of financing the operations of the district.

For _____ Against _____”

3. District 3 ballot style:

“Authorizing the creation of the Donley County Assistance District No. 3, and the imposition of a sales and use tax at the rate of 2.0 percent for purpose of financing the operations of the district.

For _____ Against _____”

Section 4

Severability

The defeat of any individual District election shall not invalidate the election in any other District. Any invalidity of any individual District shall not invalidate any other District.

Section 5


Effective Date

This Order is effective February 12th, 2024, and if adopted, will not have the result of the adoption of the tax the combined rate of sales and use taxes imposed by the County and any other political subdivisions of this state having territory in the county would exceed two percent at any location within the county.





Daniel Ford, Commissioner Precinct 2


